Haden-Guest's ascerbic drawings are well known from their regular appearance in "The New York Observer". Their spare, haiku-like humor reveals many of the unstated truths behind contemporary social interchange. The drawings seem to flow directly from the interior of the artist's mind. They are not labored and over-analyzed, but are as direct and spontaneous as the quick witted remarks one would hear when accompanying Haden-Guest on his nightly rounds of cocktail parties.

Anthony Haden-Guest has played a central role in the New York art world for more than twenty years. His book "True Colors: The Real Life of the Art World" is the ultimate insider's account of the New York art community of the '80s and '90s. His friendships with many of the important artists and his presence at many of the most memorable official and underground art world events have given him remarkable insight into the way art is created, communicated, and consumed. Those insights inform and enliven his drawings, capturing what people are really thinking as they attend art openings, but are afraid to say.
