Deitch Projects presents *Born Again*, a solo theater piece by the renown visual artist, writer and performer Liza Lou, whose life-sized beaded installations have been exhibited to overwhelming acclaim in major museums in the United States and abroad.

Born Again is a lyrical, funny and heartbreaking glimpse into a young child's early life in an Evangelical, fundamentalist family. It is a devastating depiction of love, memory and betrayal, a powerful and inventive work that gives new meaning to the word "redemption".

The performance is presented in conjunction with her solo exhibition *Testimony*, on view at 18 Wooster Street through November 30, 2002. The exhibition includes a 35 foot long trailer whose interior is entirely covered with beads, and a range of figurative sculpture. Liza Lou is a recent recipient of the MacArthur Foundation Fellowship.
